



WORKS IN KARYES

The new formation of Rachi Square

All the Karyates were delighted to receive the news about Rachi Square. As reported in the Laconic Press, the project plan concerning the square's renovation was approved and was included in the "Leader" program on a proposal of the Sparti Municipal Authority with a budget of € 440,000-.





This is a decades-long demand that significantly upgrade the Karyes lower neighborhood, since it will create a real square where the children can play safely and the adults may enjoy their coffee.

According to the project plans, only the east branch of the square will remain open to car traffic. In this way Karyes will get another beautiful stoned-paved square with flowers and trees as the site actually serves today as parking space.

The Completion of the information plates installation

The first phase of the project was completed, which significantly upgraded the image of the Karyes settlement.

The project sponsored by the **Karyates** Association (S.A.K.) and the "KARYATIS" sports **club** was also completed thanks to the financial contribution of the Ecclesiastical Council and, Mr. Michael Binis, Mr. Stavros Mermigas and Mr. Harris Konstantopoulos.

At the same time, the Association also placed an English-language information sign at the Monument of the Caryatids.

The Ecclesiastical Council with the Support Team is rapidly advancing the maintenance of the Chapel. As we can see from the published photograph, the dome of the Temple and the places where there is no external stone coverage were painted and the work concerning the protection against moisture, as described in the previous issue, is also underway.


The reception at the Karyes' Community Hall



Developing a support program for local producers in Karyes



Following the 8.29.2019 announcement / invitation of the KERCHOULAS ASSOCIATION to exchange views with local producers regarding the Local Producer Support Program being developed, it took place a meeting of interested local producers with the Management of the ASSOCIATION at the Karyes' Community Building Event Hall at 11:00 am on 8.9.2019. The meeting had an important guest, Mr. Antonis Malamis, a distinguished financial management and growth consulting company of the agri-food chain, with an emphasis on agricultural cooperatives.

The meeting was attended by several, mainly young, local producers from the **livestock**, **agriculture** (producers of chestnuts, walnuts and other products), **beekeeping** and production of **flavoring products**, as well as from the manufacturing and other professional sectors.

All issues that concern and influence local producers have been raised, such as:

- the problems of land (mainly small lots), water supply and a steady daily income,
- the end of 2021 of the existing Common Agricultural Policy ("CFP") and subsidies,
- the benefits and favor of the "New CAP" in cooperative forms and producer groups,
- economies of scale only when corporate / cooperative schemes grow, such as a significant reduction in the cost of supplies of feed, seeds, medicines and other supplies, with a serious impact on the income of each producer,
- the **reservations**, **difficulties and negative experiences** of the past regarding the effectiveness of cooperative schemes in Karyes,
- the **risks**, on the other hand, of disappearing local producers if they do not cooperate and adapt to novelties and current developments,
- the **positions of certain producers** for their immediate support on an individual basis, in particular for their necessary equipment,
- the **tools** and **solutions available** to counteract the shortage of producers in the period when they have to supply the supplies needed for their production,
- Producers' proposals regarding the Local Producer Support Program being developed are flexible and do not exclude any local producers (regarding age or permanent residence in Karyes or individuality),
- the issues of **branding** and **designation of origin** of locally produced products and the advantages of "PGI" (product with geographical indication),
- the need to develop an operational plan to direct the resources available (based on
 the decisions of the General Assembly of Karyans) to support local producers in
 targeted actions, taking into account measurable data (arable land, number of
 sheep and goats and other data from its database "OPEKEPE") and a number of
 parameters (eg refueling and refunding to the BOARD for future use, favoring
 optimum performance and certification, marking, packaging, web application
 pusher etc.),

- the **training needs** of local producers, along with the lack of interest in a very recent communication from the UNION,
- the issue of **information** on the training of local producers and the specific program of the Niarchos Foundation for the training of young people,
- the issue of **informing** young women mainly in Karya and encouraging them in group productive activities,
- the KERCHOULAS ASSOCIATION's actions on the top priority topic of the exploratory study of the exploitation of the Karyes water resources (irrigation, irrigation, small dam or reservoir, additional drilling, closed irrigation, dredging.) the findings of which will then launch as many projects as are practically and economically feasible to more effectively manage the available water resources of Karyes.

The local producers in attendance and the Management of the ASSOCIATION concluded, with obvious consensus, the following:

- **1.** The **recording of the needs** of each producer group, as well as the submission of tailored proposals to meet those needs (where possible, of course) were undertaken.
 - for the group of beekeepers, Theodoros Stathakis and Christos Leventakis,
- for the group of breeders Mr. Panos Mentis, Stathis Meleches and Nikos Kolovos,
- for the group of producers of flavorings, Andreas Voukidis, Christos Leventakis and Costas Arvanitis and
- for the group of agronomists (chestnuts, walnuts, etc.) Costas Machairas and Panagiotis Kolantzianos.
- **2.** The exploration (to the best of the visible energy in perspective) of establishing a **single cooperative scheme** of local producers with a forecast.
 - producer groups by sector,
- cost centers per group,
- groups' autonomy in decision making and
- percentage of the minimum turnover of each producer for the operational survival of the Cooperative, the establishment of which will be judged by the producers concerned on the Articles of Association and on the expected benefits for its members.

The whole process of establishing this cooperative body was undertaken by **Mr. Yiannis Kopsiavtis.**

The commitment to process, complete and submit and present the above deliverables was set for the **next two months (around the end of October 2019)**.

LOCAL NEWS

Department of Pharmacology and Chemistry of Natural Products of the Athens University School of Pharmacy: This year's Laconia olive oil is ranked in the highest rating because of its high phenols



As we were informed by **Ms Evangelia Kopsiaftis-Gionis**, (member of the Board of Directors of our Association) who is also olive oil producer herself, **this year's Laconia Organic Oil is top rated because of the especially high number of phenols.**

According to the Athens University School of Pharmacy It is a product of superior nutritional value that protects the human body far more effectively than the widely advertised sturgeon oil which is an animal product. For this reason, it was awarded in a special event which took place at the Greece's Old Parliament House, receiving the Silver Prize in the category of Therapeutic and Health Care Olive Oil.



In the next issue we will come back with more information, as we believe at the high quality of the traditional Greek products and especially we strongly believe that the extra virgin olive oil (also called the "Greek Gold") should be recognized mainly as a medical product.
