## **CLUB'S NEWS**

## Announcement from the president of the "Karyatis" Sports Club concerning the new indoor hall



According to two announcements published on **January 20** and **June 17, 2023**, "After a 12-month process, the change of use of the former warehouse of the Agricultural Cooperative to an indoor space of cultural and sports facilities was approved (Permit No. 513340 | 26-10-22). However, after the completion of the licensing, the Board of Directors found that the financial situation of the Sports Club is not sufficient to carry out the work of locker rooms etc., and therefore a source of funding was sought. By chance, we received an information that on **Monday, December 5, 2022**, a presentation would take place at the Sparta Library, by the **Parnonas Development Organization S.A**. for the new local strategy Leader CAP 2023-2027. The chairman of the Board of Directors Mr. **Theodoros Mentis** attended, requested and received relevant information material. Afterwards, he met with the head of the Organization in Tripoli (Mr. Beretsos) and the competent "Ecotopos" office that prepares the files.

Therefore, the Sports Club BoD prepared the necessary supporting documents, which it submitted on January 18, 2023 to the responsible office and informed the engineer to draw up his own. Also, on December 9, 2022, the Secretary of the Karyates Association Mr. Harris Konstantopoulos, had an online meeting on the same topic and on December 16, 2022, he addressed on all the village's Clubs and Associations to generate information and interest. This was followed IMMEDIATELY by the submission of a relevant file to the Parnonas Development Organization S.A. for financing the necessary works (locker rooms, insulation, roof, etc.). Since then, although the members of the Board were informed that the call for interest would be published at the end of January 2023, it was finally postponed to the end of 2023. This means that the space cannot yet be used and everyone and especially the children will have to have patience".

We wish that within the next few months the project will be included so that work can begin.

## "Aghioi Anargyri" club: Account report and election for a new BoD

On **June 11, 2023**, the Club's General Assembly was held. According to a related announcement: "The assembly should have been held normally at the end of the three-year period, however, since 2 members of the Board of Directors have resigned, we are obliged to shorten the elections because with an incomplete Board of Directors we cannot operate and let's make decisions". Regarding the works in which the union has participated:

At the Aghioi Anargyri Chapel: "First of all, all the works were always done with the consent of the Ecclesiastical (Church) Council and the Holy Diocese (Metropolis) and so all the necessary permits were issued. The first project was to stabilize the foundations. The foundations stability, as you well know, was done by a special crew in the summer of 2019 that we operated as an informal volunteer group. Our engineer found a company that deals with such special constructions and with the permission of the Church Building Committee the works were completed. Specifically, 13 cement columns were built in the ground near the foundations with a diameter of 35 centimeters and at a great depth. As you understand these important tasks are not visible.

The second important project was the **support of the masonry**, where the dangerous cracks in the walls had to be repaired and generally the fixing of the entire building. We received three offers which were evaluated by the engineer with techno-economic criteria. Then we got the permission to carry out the work from the Holy Diocese and then the required permission was issued by the Church Building Committee. Thus, last year in June, the repair work of the masonry was carried out again by the special workshop that deals with this type of work, i.e., the cleaning of the plasters on the outside, the grouting with special machines and the drainage of grouts to support the masonry with approximately 14,000 liters of special material that binds the whole construction. With these works and the initial foundation, the building became solid and secured for many - many years.

The third important project was the **support work inside the Temple** because the plasters were falling and there were also large cracks in the walls inside. The fixing was done with reinforced shotcrete (GUNAITE method) by the same workshop that has applied this technique to the fixing of the old Acropolis Museum in Athens. Then, the necessary plastering work was carried out inside and the fixing of the iconostasis with cement injections.

Finally, the fourth project was the **repair of the dome** and the damage to the roof to ensure against moisture and the replacement of all the old doors and windows with new ones. The purpose of our Club is for the projects that we carried out to last for many years, so we try to have the work done with modern methods and by experienced crews. With all the above works the building was secured internally and externally and this is where our own activity stops as the permission we had from the Metropolis and the church council was essentially the fixing and securing of the building. All that remains is tiling and painting internally as well as some external landscaping. These works will be done by the Church Council, and we will help where we can and we are in good cooperation with **Father Leontios** for this purpose.

For the other Chapels, "as you all saw last year on August 15 the **Temple of Dormition of the Virgin Mary (Panaghia)** has become a real gem with the costs having been offered by the family of **Maria Alexaki Koutsogeorgas**, while last year we did some minor repairs to **Chapel of Agioi Konstantinos and Heleni,** i.e., repair of doors and windows, repair of dome, grips and frames around the frames". Reference was also made to the visit of the professors of the Athens Agricultural University (And. Papadopoulos and Natassa Pantera) with the purpose of examining the old plane trees of Panagia and the trees of Ai Thanasis and Kakaris, so that they can be designated monuments of nature and protected (extensive reference has done in previous issues).

Regarding the financial data, it was mentioned that "In the three years of its activity, our Club managed the amount of  $\in$  **56,000**- approximately ( $\in$  41,000- for Aghioi Anargyri and  $\in$  15,000- for Panagia) in order to carry out the above projects. The exact figures can be found in the annual reports of the Audit Committee. All the money came from donations of our patriots at home and abroad who trusted us. We thank everyone for the trust they have shown us." Finally, it was mentioned that there is approximately an amount of  $\in$  **4,200**- left in the fund, which the donor earmarks for the remaining works at the Chapel of Agioi Anargyro and the Board of Directors is in consultation with Father Leontios to find the way in which this money will be allocated for the purpose desired by the donor.

According the statements made at the General Assembly, there is a willingness from the Club to be active in other areas as well, such as beautification and cleaning of public spaces always in collaboration with local authorities and other bodies, events-information on social issues, health, etc. by inviting expert speakers for each topic, while a dream is, also in collaboration with other institutions of the village, the creation of a small theater in the area of Saint John (Aghios Iohannis) in the Community Clock ("Roloi").

The elections followed where the new <u>Board of Directors</u> was elected consisting of: Ms. Demetra Karaboukalou-Voukides (President), Ms. Demetra Prekezes (Vice-President), Ms. Panaghiota Kyriazis (General Secretary), Mr. Andreas Voukides (Treasurer), Ms. Heleni Kardaras (Public Relations) and alternate member Ms. Florina Onofrei-Sarri. Ms. Maria Leventakes (Chairman), Ms. Demetra Lavatses and Ms. Demetra Repoules (Members) and Ms Areti Koutsogeorgas (Substitute Member) were elected to the <u>Election-Audit Committee</u>.

The **Karyates Association** Board of Directors congratulates all the members of the new elected Bod of the Club and wishes them to succeed at their goals.


Greetings!



Welcome back to Karyae Park. We are here to celebrate a historic moment of 100 years of the organization- Adelphotis Arahoviton Karyae and Karyae Park. What a joyous and gratifying day to commemorate 100 years. One hundred years. I see here today so many relatives and dear friends that are descendants of the village of Arahova.

You are here today to see loved ones and dear friends that you would see here over the years every August at the annual picnic. But a part of you is here in honor of your relatives, who created this organization 100 years ago. You are grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews of these bold men, who created the Adelphotis and built this place, our Karyae Park. Let's go back to the early years of the 20th century. Arahovites had started migrating to America, Canada, and Australia. Here in this area these Arahovites started their lives in Gastonia, Charlotte, Spartanburg and Greenville. They started their families and prospered in America. However, they did not forget their beloved birthplace, Arahova. In 1923, this group of men decided to form this organization, the Adelphotis Arahoviton Karyae. Their love for their village, it's people there and the Arahoviti immigrants here in America, inspired the group to start the Adelphotis. These 10 men were the founders: Peter J. Mandanis of Spartanburg, South Carolina, Nicholas D. Kaperonis of Charlotte, North Carolina, Chris P. Leventis of Gastonia, North Carolina, Peter N. Harakas of Greenville, South Carolina, Matthew D. Karres of Charlotte, North Carolina, Peter P. Leventis of Gastonia, North Carolina, Ernest G. Kopses Paraskevas K. Pitsios, Andrew S. Pappas of Charlotte, North Carolina and **Andrew S. Trakas** of Gastonia, North Carolina. Their vision was to help the Arahoviti immigrants with gaining citizenship, financial assistance, housing, medical and burial expenses.

The Adelphotis is an official charitable organization. In the Certificate of Incorporation, it states its purpose "to aid our kinsmen in our native home, Arahova, assisting the welfare and comfort of our loved ones there and in this country of adoption." Also, "to encourage education, religion, better moral and social condition among members and fellow Arahovites." I am certain that you know of the stories told of the organization doing exactly this. Let's think of what happened in Arahova over the last 100 years. The village endured 2 world wars, Nazi occupation, the burning of homes throughout the village, the Civil war... This is when the Adelphotis stepped forward. The Adelphotis came through in a big way for the village. There were 2 major contributions. 100 years ago, there wasn't a school to educate its children in the village. The Adelphotis stepped forward to fund the building of the school there. Today the school is still serving the education of the children in the village. The other major project involved the water supply. The village had limited water. It had 2 springs and a handful of spigots scattered about the village. The Adelphotis funded the water infrastructure, where all homes were equipped with water supply. For the last 60 years the village is in a better place. An intimate, beautiful, peaceful place on a side of a mountain.

















Many of you here today travel to Greece and Arahova in the summer to vacation and visit family and friends. To relax, to enjoy, to reminisce. Arahova is certainly a place to be proud of. I have not forgotten one other major accomplishment. The founders and members desired a place similar to the village. They found it right here, Karyae Park. 45 acres and near a mountain. They bought the property and built this place and here we are. Over the 100 years the park has hosted weddings, baptisms, church services, makaronadas, our traditional Saint George Picnic and our annual August picnic. The August picnic was always a highlight of our summers growing up. Fellowship, music, and dancing late into the night. What fun. Here today are many long serving members and supporters, that are dedicated to the Adelphotis. Serving on the board and handling the business aspects. For decades, the ladies prepare and serve the pastries. They care for the church. Doing what is needed behind the scenes. Many dedicated men cooking and taking on the task to prepare the meals, year after year. Those members and Arahovites that we have lost are honored every year, following the divine Liturgy service at the monument in a memorial service at every August picnic. In 1965, the Adelphotis started the Karyae Benevolent Foundation. It's purpose is assist Arahovites in need and award scholarships every year to students here and in Greece. Today the Foundation awards up \$15,000 annually.

Right now, in 2023, many of you may be curious of where are right now. We currently have over 100 members, the Foundation continues to award scholarship money and help Arahovites in need. We continue the traditions of the Saint George Picnic and the August picnic. We have Saturday church services. The church and administration building have been extensively renovated. Go and take a look. Recently, the Adelphotis was contacted by the president of the organization in Arahova, that leads the project of the restorations of the churches in the village. The Adelphotis board approved to contribute to the restoration project and it will continue to support the project. The president wrote a letter thanking us for our our support and to congratulate us on our 100 years. It bears repeating that the founders wanted to encourage education, religion, the well-being of its people and improve the moral and social condition among its members and fellow Arahovitans.
