Installation of digital water meters in the villages of the Sparta Municipality

According to the relevant announcement:

"The Municipal Authority and the Administration of the "SPARTA MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY AND SEWERAGE PUBLIC COMPANY (D.E.Y.A.S.)" are pleased to announce that on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, the project received the relevant approvals from the Special Secretary for Program Management (European E.S.P.A.) Mr. Giorgos Zervos and the proposal was included for financing. The project, with a total budget of € 6,134,366.00 concerns the replacement of all conventional water meters in the Municipal Units of Mystras, Oinountos, Faridos, Pellana and Karyes of the Municipality of Sparta with digital water meters, which will ensure the absolute managerial competence in the control of the water supply network.

In particular, the technical study drawn up by the Technical Service

of the D.E.Y.A.S., and which was approved in its entirety, includes: 1) Supply, installation and commissioning of a total of 12,870 local consumption monitoring stations to monitor all critical parameters such as consumption, indication of leakage, breakage, water cut and malicious activities. Through these stations, the non-invoiced water related to the under-subscription of the existing outdated metering system will be drastically reduced, while the breaks and leaks will be detected immediately and with complete accuracy.

2) Supply of portable control stations for electronic water meter programming, control and spot detection of leaks in the network consisting of portable electronic water meter programmers, portable network surveyor and portable flow meter.

3) Expansion and upgrade of the existing Central Control Station where all the necessary work and additions of equipment and software will be done for the expansion of the existing remotecontrol system.


4) Training of the staff of the service in the new functions".

In addition, the Mayor of Sparta, Mr. Petros Doukas, stated "The concerns about the constant decrease in the availability of drinking water, the predicted upcoming decrease in rainfall worldwide by 40% by 2030, as well as the insufficient in many cases proper water management, make up the main factors that push us to take water management one more step forward for the benefit of all our citizens". Afterwards, he congratulated the Director of D.E.Y.A.S. Mr. Helias Trakakis, the Company's Technical Service and all those who worked to achieve the above development. Finally, the President of D..E.Y.A.S. Ms. Dedemidou, mentioned the great importance of the project and thanked the company's services for their actions in order to submit the relevant proposal on time as well as all the members of the Board of Directors for their cooperation.

However, we consider that while the project is necessary for the 21st century, it should also take into account the peculiarities of the region and especially of the mountain settlements such as Karyes. E.g. care should be taken so that the residents are not charged during the heavy winter season where for safety reasons the taps should be left slightly open so as not to cause frost damage.

Memorial of Benefactor Athanasios Matalas

On Sunday, April 30, 2023 and after the end of the divine service at Aghia Paraskevi, presided over by archpriest Georgios Blathras and the priest father Leontios the memorial service was held for the repose of the soul of the Great Benefactor of Karyes, Athanasios Matalas of Lacedaimon. Local and Municipal Authorities, members of the Board of Directors of the Matalas Foundation attended among with many people. The Karyates Association was represented by the president Mr. Michalis Repoulis.



The contribution of Benefactor to the place requires a whole book to be described and epigraphically it is worth mentioning his presence as consul in Balkan cities, where he opened the way for dozens of his compatriots to immigrate there, to do business in industries such as the grain trade, the distillery and catering. This wealth was transferred to Karyes, transforming the place and saving its residents in periods of low wheat production with massive food imports from these regions. With his presence in various government positions and his term as Local Mayor, he upgraded with his experience the standard of living in the entire region (creation of a walnut forest with seeds from the forests of Eastern Romilia, Bulgaria, construction of a road network, etc.).

His contribution to Karyes continues to this day and in the future through the system of scholarships for the students of Karyes and Lacedaemon region that he established in his will and is consistently implemented by the Board of Directors of the Matalas Foundation which was also created by his will.

May his example and offering find imitators.

The celebration of the National Day of March 25

The anniversary of the Greek Revolution of 1821 was celebrated with the customary eulogy at the Main Church of Agios Andreas, followed by the recitation of poems by the students of the Karyes primary school and the laying of wreaths on the Heroon in the Central Square.

EASTER 2023 IN KARYES

The businessman, philanthropist and founder of the "Greek Children's Fund" has passed away

On Sunday, March 19, 2023, the distinguished expatriate **Stylianos Matthaiou (Stanley Matthews**) died in New Jersey, U.S.A. at the age of 93. He was born in 1930 and grew up in a large family in Varvitsa, Laconia. In 1951, he came to America for a better fortune and together with his brothers, they got involved in restaurants. His family principles, his hard and honest work made him a worthy businessman with the famous restaurants "**Matthews Diner**".

The deceased was not only a worthy family man and an elite member of the Greek Community, but also his philanthropic work extended to his ancestral village and with countless philanthropic events in institutions of religious and public benefit. The highlight of his sensitive soul was the establishment in 1983 of the "Greek Children's Fund" (a foundation for Greek children with cancer) which has grown throughout America and offers valuable help to children with cancer from Greece and Cyprus, covering many of their hospital expenses in America.

At his last days he was accompanied by the love of his wife Niki nee Papadimitriou from Voutianus Laconia, his children, grandchildren, relatives and friends who will all remember him with appreciation and love.

Karyes Cultural Club's initiative for village's cleaning

The annual voluntary cleaning of Karyes public spaces was carried out by the members and friends of the Karyes Cultural Club on Saturday, April 8, 2023, a few days before the Holy Week. Specifically, and with the support of the "Karyatis' Sports Club, the voluntary cleaning of both cemeteries took place.



According to a related post on FB by the secretary of the Club Mr. Demetrios Arvanitis "unfortunately this initiative did not find the support it should have, as the residents' response to the call for voluntary participation was not what was expected", the cleaning took place.

The conclusion from the initiative was that "although the lower cemetery was in good condition, without garbage and with little grass, the situation in the upper cemetery is shameful. In addition to all kinds of vegetation (grass, cottonwood, ivy, figs, etc.), the doors are damaged, there is rubble everywhere, broken marble, and unfortunately garbage thrown everywhere."

And the post continues: "The municipal authority has an obligation to immediately take all the necessary actions so that these shameful images do not exist again. The Municipality collects € 15.00 per year for each grave, with the revenues being remunerative and must go to the purpose of their collection. People who have passed away deserve our least respect. We throw our garbage in the bins and not elsewhere.

With the no. 57/21-03-3023 decision of the financial department of the Municipality of Sparta, it has been decided to commission a service entitled "Cemetery cleaning and beautification works" except for the city of Sparta, with the amount of € 30,000.00 (78 cemeteries). Of particular interest is the work schedule table, where it lists the work that should be done each month from April to September.

Waiting for the works, hoping that they will also be carried out in the cemeteries of our village. We will closely monitor the matter as for the payment of the contractor there will have to be a relevant certificate and receipt of the works".

Karyates Association building: the works continues at a feverish pace

The works in the complex of buildings of the Association in Karyes main square continue intensively. Indicatively, several works were completed in the spring, mainly in the interior spaces such as the installation of the elevator, the polishing of the mosaic floors and the completion of the ground floor bathrooms. At the same time, many external works were completed, whenever the weather conditions allowed, e.g. the installation of the roof in the area of the square, the external plastering at the back of the building, while the walls painting has also begun. It is worth noting that after many efforts and bureaucratic procedures a lot of things that had to do with the general operation of the building, such as the electrification with renewal and modification of the relevant licenses were completed.

The project continues and the contribution of the chairman of the Board of Directors should be highlighted. Mr. Michalis Repoulis, who together with his wife Ms Demetra Kakaris, all this time have been staying in the village in order to supervise the work, while they make continuous trips to Tripoli and Sparta to solve any issues.

Helen "Lela" (Theodorakakis) Aggelopoulos passed away on May 18, 2023, at the age of 84 in London Ontario Canada



She was born in Karyes on December 18, 1939, where she lived through the difficult years of the Nazi occupation and the first postwar years and was the daughter of Demetrios and Kalliope Theodorakakis. There she finished school while helping her family. At the age of 20, in 1959, she immigrated to Canada where she was preceded or followed by the rest of the siblings: Ioanna (Jeanette) widow of Georgiou Saldari, Maria widow of Jim Milles, Antonios (Tony) and Theodoros.

There's not a person that ever stopped by Lela's home that didn't end up staying over for coffee, a drink, or a bite to eat at a table full of lively and wonderful conversation. Life at the Aggelopoulos home was full of many joyous family gatherings, celebrations, Sunday family dinners, and special occasions.

In Canada, she quickly got involved in the many lively activities of her new community and church and began building her large network of friendships that would last a lifetime. A few years later she met and married her beloved husband Konstantinos (Gus) Angelopoulos with whom they lived together for 58 years having two sons and three grandchildren.

She started her career in Canada at Forsythe's Dry Cleaners and then fulfilled a passion to run her own business Helen's Variety and Alterations (at the corner of Colborne and Pall Mall Streets in London), which she ran side-by-side every step of the way with Kosta from the early 70's until their retirement. Those lucky enough to have lived nearby will remember it being the heart of the community where you were welcomed as if you were a part of the family on every visit.

She led a passionate life of volunteerism and commitment for her beloved Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church and community. Over the past 50 years there wasn't a single bake sale, Kavalkade, Panorama, OPA Festival, walkathon, fundraiser, or raffle just to name a few that Lela wasn't working at and rallying the ladies of the community. She also spent many years on the Board of Directors of the Hellenic Community Council of London and as President of the Greek Ladies Philoptochos Society.

Lela's life was a life of love for everyone she knew and met. She was a model of caring, compassion, generosity, and integrity. She was tough, and true to her Spartan roots she was a fighter, although she met with great adversity in her life, she always faced it head on with dignity and resolve and always without complaint. Despite her sudden, tragic, and unexpected passing Helen, a truly great lady and proud family matriarch, she will be remembered for her bright smile that lit every room she entered, her amazing positive attitude towards life, and her absolute devotion to her family and friends.
